2018 HIV SURVEILLANCE DATA





In the U.S.

- In 2018, an estimated 37,968 people received an HIV diagnosis in the United States. 1 in 7 individuals living with HIV don't know their status. (cdc.gov, Jan 7, 2019).
- HIV rates are highest in the southern United States (AL, AR, DE, DC, FL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NC, OK, SC, TN, TX, VA, WV).

STATE DATA

In Texas

- As of 2018, **94,106** individuals were known to be living with HIV in Texas since the beginning of the epidemic.
- 4,520 cases of HIV were newly diagnosed in Texas in 2018,



Disparities

- Gay and Bisexual men continue to be most affected by the HIV epidemic in the U.S.
- At current rates.
 - 1 in 6 MSM will be diagnosed with HIV in their lifetime,
 - 1 in 2 black MSM
 - 1 in 4 Latino MSM
 - 1 in 11 white MSM (Center for Disease Control and Prevention 2016)


Texas - HIV Diagnosis Rates by Sex at birth and Year of Diagnosis, 2008-2018








Texas - HIV Diagnosis Rates by Age at Diagnosis, 2018



Texas - New HIV Diagnoses by Mode of Transmission, 2009-2018








Texas - New HIV Diagnoses Among Priority Populations. 2008 & 2018






Texas - Prevalence Rate of PLWH by Sex Assigned at Birth, 2005-2018






Texas PLWHA by Mode of Transmission, 2018








HIV Prevalence by Priority Group 2009-2018




El Paso - PLWHA by Gender Identity, 2018




El Paso - PLWHA & New HIV Diagnoses by Age Group, 2018




El Paso - Treatment & Linkage to Care

El Paso HSDA HIV Population Treatment Cascade, 2017



- HIV+ Individuals at end of 2017 No. of HIV+ individuals (alive) at the end of 2017.
- At Least One Visit in 2017 No. of PLWH with a met need (at least one: medical visit, ART prescription, VL test, or CD4 test) in 2017.
- Retained in Care is number of PLWH with at least 2 visits or labs, at least 3 months apart or suppressed at end of 2017.
- Achieved Viral Suppression at end of 2016 No. of PLWH whose last viral load test value of 2017 was <= 200 copies/mL.
